Being involved in ground breaking deep shipwreck explorations Leigh Bishop has been able to relay the story's behind these discoveries as a public speaker, lecturer and conference adviser to hundreds of people. His presentations were a direct result of successful image creation and as he admits something that makes his job as a public speaker somewhat easier even to audiences of up to 5-600 people. Originally asked to present on the Britannic 98 expedition to a local club he has now conducted dozens of presentations and lecturers around the British Isles. Together with diving colleague Geraint Ffoulkes Jones, Leigh Bishop donated all of the proceeds of the Britannic 98 talks to charity. His credits as a public speaker to date include the Australasian Diving Technologies Conference Sydney, Australia as well as the Royal Geographical Society London, Birmingham & London DIVE shows on many occasions, conferences in Ireland, Scotland and Wales, Warwick University, Imperial College London, Birmingham University as well as many UK dive clubs.
